# GLOCK'S DREAM BOY



GLOCK's Dream Boy verenigt de drie belangrijkste hengstelijnen van Nederland in zich. Deze hoogbenige bloedmooie hengst was de eerste zwarte KWPN gekeurde zoon van Vivaldi die Krack C en Jazz in zijn stamboom verenigt. Moedersvader Ferro is o.a. de vader van Edward Gal's Olympiade paard GLOCK's Undercover en grootvader van Olympisch kampioen Valegro.

GLOCK's Dream Boy, die zelf in 2014 brons won op het Wereldkampioenschap jonge paarden, heeft inmiddels meerdere goedgekeurde zonen en kampioensmerries voortgebracht. Daaronder ook Kane (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Krack C) die met 8,25 gemiddeld tijdens de sporttest in februari 2020 overtuigde. Tijdens de driedaagse test in Verden scoorde hij zelfs 9,09 gemiddeld met een 10 voor Rittigheid. Nakomeling Monte Carlo TC, die voor de helft verkocht is aan Blue Hors, is met 88 punten voor zijn verrichting goedgekeurd bij het KWPN. In 2019 werd een zoon van GLOCK's Dream Boy op de veiling in Westfalen, voor een bedrag van 1.9 miljoen euro verkocht.


Ook bij de Pavo Cup zijn de nakomelingen van GLOCK's Dream Boy goed vertegenwoordigd, waarbij Dutch Dream (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Fürst Romancier) in 2022 brons behaalde bij de vierjarigen en in 2023 Myeline (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Don Schufro) en Mercurius ACM (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Gribaldi) bij de zesjarigen positief opvielen. Deze laatste hengst werd begin 2023 met 90,67 punten de verrichtingstopper bij het NRPS, in 2022 won hij al de Subli Competitie met een score van 91,6 punten en eindigde onder Amber Hage bij de Hippiade 2023 bovenaan in de klasse Z2. Daarnaast leverde GLOCK's Dream Boy in zowel 2020 als 2022 de nationaal kampioene bij de driejarige dressuurmerries, namelijk respectievelijk Magna Charta (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Sir Oldenburg) en Ostara ST-J (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Totilas). Bovendien lopen er meerdere nakomelingen succesvol op Grand Prix-niveau, waaronder de ruïn 'Holiday' met zijn amazone Gerdine Maree en Iago (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Jazz) onder Liesbeth Geven, die veelbelovende combinaties vormen. Al deze successen bewijzen dat GLOCK's Dream Boy zijn uitzonderlijke kwaliteiten overdraagt aan zijn nakomelingen.

GLOCK's Dream Boy is met zijn ruiter Hans Peter Minderhoud zeer succesvol op het hoogste niveau en een vaste waarde voor het Nederlandse team. De combinatie beleefde al vele sportieve hoogtepunten waaronder het NK Dressuur, waar ze vier jaar op rij het zilver veroverden. Enkele hoogtepunten uit de sportieve carrière van GLOCK's Dream Boy tot nu toe zijn onder meer; deelname aan de Wereldruiterspelen in Tryon, het Europees Kampioenschap in Rotterdam en de Wereldbekerfinale in Göteborg. Daarnaast maakten ze deel uit van het Nederlandse team op de Olympische Spelen in Tokio en het Europees Kampioenschap in Hagen.

GLOCK's Dream Boy brings together the three most important Dutch stallion bloodlines. This long-legged black horse was the first KWPN-licensed son of Vivaldi in this sought-after black coloration who, in turn, embodied the bloodlines of the famous stallions Krack C and Jazz in his ancestry. His damsire, Ferro, is the father of Edward Gal's famous Olympic horse, GLOCK's Undercover, and grandfather of the Olympic winner, Valegro.

GLOCK's Dream Boy, who won bronze at the World Championships for Young Dressage Horses in 2014, already has several licensed sons and elite mares. These include Kane (Dream Boy x Krack C), who stood out during the sports test in February 2020 with an average of 8.25. During the three-day test in Verden, he scored an average of 9.09 with a 10 for rideability. Offspring Monte Carlo TC, 50% owned by Blue Hors, has been approved by the KWPN, with 88 points for his performance. In 2019, a son of GLOCK's Dream Boy was bought at the auction in Westphalia for 1.9 million euros.

The offspring of GLOCK's Dream Boy are also well represented at the Pavo Cup, with Dutch Dream (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Fürst Romancier) taking bronze in the four-year-olds in 2022 and Myeline (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Don Schufro) and Mercurius ACM (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Gribaldi) in the six-year-olds. The latter stallion became the NRPS performance leader at the beginning of 2023 with 90.67 points. As soon as 2022, he won the Subli Competition with a score of 91.6 points and was the Z2 class winner under Amber Hage at the 2023 Hippiade. GLOCK's Dream Boy also sired the national winners of the three-year-old dressage mares in 2020 and 2022 - Magna Charta (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Sir Oldenburg) and Ostara ST-J (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Totilas). Several offspring of GLOCK's Dream Boy are already successfully presented at Grand Prix level, including the gelding "Holiday" with his rider Gerdine Maree and Iago (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Jazz) under Liesbeth Geven, both of which are promising combinations. All these successes prove that GLOCK's Dream Boy passes on his exceptional qualities to his descendants.

With Hans Peter Minderhoud he has performed at Grand Prix level with great success and is an important member of the Dutch dressage team. The duo have already experienced many sporting highlights including the Dutch National Dressage Championships, where they won silver four years in a row. Some highlights of GLOCK's Dream Boy's sporting career so far include; participation in the World Equestrian Games in Tryon, the European Championship in Rotterdam and the World Cup Final in Gothenburg. They were also on the Dutch team at the Olympic Games in Tokyo and the European Championships in Hagen.





GLOCK's Dream Boy vereint die drei bedeutendsten Hengstlinien der Niederlande und war der erste KWPN gekörte Sohn des Vivaldi in der begehrten Rappfarbe, welcher die berühmten Hengste Krack C und Jazz in seiner Abstammung vereint. Sein Muttervater Ferro ist Vater von Edward Gals berühmtem Olympiapferd GLOCK's Undercover und Großvater des Olympiasiegers Valegro.

Er selbst gewann bei der WM der jungen Dressurpferde 2014 Bronze und hat bereits mehrere gekörte Söhne und prämierte Töchter. Darunter den KWPN Hengst Kane (Dream Boy x Krack C), der bei der Hengstleistungsprüfung im Februar 2020 mit gesamt 8,25 überzeugte. Während des Drei-Tage-Tests in Verden erhielt er eine Gesamtnote von 9,09 mit einer 10 für Rittigkeit. Bei der KWPN Körung 2020 überzeugte Blue Hors Monte Carlo mit 88 Punkten und wurde als Prämienhengst ausgewählt. Bei der westfälischen Körung 2019 stellte GLOCK's Dream Boy den Siegerhengst, der für 1,9 Millionen Euro verkauft wurde.

Auch beim Pavo Cup sind die Nachkommen von GLOCK's Dream Boy gut vertreten, wobei Dutch Dream (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Fürst Romancier) mit Bronze bei den Vierjährigen 2022 sowie Myeline (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Don Schufro) und Mercurius ACM (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Gribaldi) bei den Sechsjährigen 2023 auf sich aufmerksam machten. Der KWPN Hengst Mercurius ACM wurde Anfang 2023 mit 90,67 Punkten zum NRPS-Leistungsträger, 2022 gewann er bereits den Subli-Wettbewerb mit 91,6 Punkten und wurde unter Amber Hage auf der Hippiade 2023 Sieger der Klasse Z2. GLOCK's Dream Boy stellte weiters auch die Bundessiegerinnen der dreijährigen Dressurstuten 2020 und 2022 - Magna Charta (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Sir Oldenburg) und Ostara ST-J (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Totilas). Mehrere Nachkommen von GLOCK's Dream Boy werden bereits erfolgreich auf Grand Prix-Niveau vorgestellt, darunter der Wallach Holiday mit seiner Reiterin Gerdine Maree oder Iago (GLOCK's Dream Boy x Jazz) unter Liesbeth Geven, die beide vielversprechende Kombinationen darstellen. Viele Erfolge, die GLOCK's Dream Boy als Top-Vererber bestätigen.

GLOCK's Dream Boy wird von Hans Peter Minderhoud höchst erfolgreich auf Grand Prix Niveau vorgestellt und ist seit Jahren festes Mitglied der niederländischen Dressur-Equipe. Die beiden konnten bereits zahlreiche sportliche Höhepunkte feiern und holten bei den Niederländischen Dressurmeisterschaften vier Jahre in Folge Silber. Einige Highlights der bisherigen Sportkarriere von GLOCK's Dream Boy sind: Teilnahme an den Weltreiterspielen in Tryon, der Europameisterschaft in Rotterdam und dem Weltcup-Finale in Göteborg. Außerdem waren sie Teil der niederländischen Nationalmannschaft bei den Olympischen Spielen in Tokio und der Europameisterschaft in Hagen.

GLOCK's Energy was een opvallende premiehengst op de Hannoveraner Hengstenkeuring in 2021. Deze schitterende zwarte hengst van Escamillo x De Niro x Prince Thatch xx, gefokt door 2M2 Horses i Båstad AB (Zweden), beweegt met veel actie en ruimte in zijn uitgestrekte gangen en beschikt over veel zelfhouding, elasticiteit en expressie. GLOCK's Energy heeft in de eerste drie generaties van zijn afstamming maar liefst zes voorouders die succesvol op Grand Prix-niveau zijn uitgebracht. Via zijn vader Escamillo (Escolar x Rohdiamant x De Niro) voegt GLOCK's Energy interessant en vernieuwend bloed toe in de Nederlandse fokkerij. Daarnaast is het invloedrijke Rubinstein-bloed, wat voor komt in de afstamming van een aantal GLOCK-hengsten, ook bij deze interessante Escamillo-zoon aanwezig.

Ook bijzonder interessant is de aanwezigheid van Volbloed en Anglo-Arabische hengsten in de afstamming van GLOCK's Energy, deze hengsten hebben al meermaals bewezen nakomelingen te kunnen leveren die succesvol presteren op internationaal Grand Prix-niveau. Hierbij valt te denken aan de hengsten Inshallah AA, Prince Thatch xx en Angelo xx, laatstgenoemde is de vader van Amon, welke met Annemarie Sanders-Keijzer twee keer deelnam aan de Olympische Spelen en Ahlerich, die uiterst succesvol was onder de legendarische Dr. Rainer Klimke.

De moeder van GLOCK's Energy, Darina, gefokt door Hubert Ratermann, komt uit de Colona merrielij, waaruit onder andere het bekende dressuurpaard Rubens (v. Rubinstein) is voortgekomen. Darina gaf naast GLOCK's Energy maar liefst twee andere goedgekeurde zonen (beiden van Sir Donnerhall), namelijk Schneefuss en zijn volle broer Kilian, die helaas te vroeg is overleden.

Zijn vader Escamillo (v. Escolar x Rohdiamant) wordt beschouwd als een van Duitslands meest opvallende jonge dressuurpaarden sinds zijn goedkeuring in Verden in 2017. Deze Rheinlander-hengst was de eerste Escolar-zoon die als premiehengst de ring verliet. In 2020 won hij de sporttest in Verden met toonaangevende eindscore van 9,36 punten, in 2021 bewees Escamillo opnieuw zijn talent in de dressuurbaan met een zilveren medaille op het WK voor jonge dressuurpaarden in Verden, welke hij in 2022 met een derde plaats en 83,072% bij de zevenjarige dressuurpaarden nog eens onderschreef.

GLOCK's Energy behaalde bij de ‚Hengstleistungsprüfung‘ in Warendorf 7,86 punten en hij bleef niet onopgemerkt. Het Oldenburger verband heeft hem direct erkend. In 2023 heeft hij tijdens de sporttest in Münster-Handorf 8,31 punten behaald en op het WK jonge paarden behaalde hij de finale in de rubriek voor de vierjarigen en eindigde met 82,80% op de zesde plaats

GLOCK's Energy was an outstanding Premium Stallion at the 2021 Hanoverian Stallion Licensing. This smart black stallion by Escamillo x De Niro x Prince Thatch xx, bred by 2M2 Horses i Båstad AB (Sweden), demonstrates plenty of knee action during his extended movements and moves his entire body with verve and great elasticity.

GLOCK's Energy has no less than six Grand Prix ancestors in the first three generations of his pedigree, among them the sire of the century, De Niro. Through his sire Escamillo von Escolar x Rohdiamant x De Niro, GLOCK's Energy not only brings fresh blood to Dutch breeding but additionally once again the connection with the important Rubinstein blood that often appears in the pedigrees of GLOCK stallions. Also particularly interesting is the presence of thoroughbred and Anglo-Arabian stallions, which produced offspring up to Grand Prix level. For example Inshallah AA, Prince Thatch xx and Angelo xx, the sire of Amon and Ahlerich, who was highly successful under the legendary Dr. Rainer Klimke.

The dam of GLOCK's Energy, Darina (breeder: Hubert Ratermann), comes from the Colona mare line, which produced famous dressage horses such as Rubens v. Rubinstein. In addition to GLOCK's Energy, Darina produced no fewer than two other approved sons (both by Sir Donnerhall), namely Schneefuss and his full brother Kilian, who unfortunately passed away too early.

His sire Escamillo v. Escolar-Rohdiamant has been considered one of Germany's most eye-catching young dressage horses since his licensing in Verden in 2017. This Rhineland stallion was the first Escolar son to leave the ring as a premium stallion. In 2020 he won the sport test in Verden with a dressage-dominated final score of 9.36 points while, in 2021, he provided further proof of his talent in the dressage arena with a silver medal at the World Championships for Young Dressage Horses in Verden, which he further underlined in 2022 with third place (83.072%) in the seven-year-old dressage horse class.

GLOCK's Energy scored a total of 7.86 points at the 2022 stallion performance test in Warendorf and was also approved for Oldenburg. In 2023, he achieved 8.31 points at the sport test in Münster-Handorf and, at the FEI WBFSH Dressage World Breeding Championship for Young Horses, he reached the final in the four-year-olds section and finished in sixth place with 82.80%



GLOCK's Energy war herausragender Prämienhengst der Hannoveraner Hengstkörung 2021. Der schicke Rappe von Escamillo x De Niro x Prince Thatch xx aus der Zucht von 2M2 Horses i Båstad AB (Schweden) ist bei raumgreifenden Bewegungen mit viel Knieaktion ausgestattet und bewegt sich mit viel Elastizität schwingvoll durch den Körper.

GLOCK's Energy hat in den ersten drei Generationen seines Pedigrees nicht weniger als sechs Grand-Prix-Vorfahren, unter anderem den Jahrhundertvererber De Niro. Über seinen Vater Escamillo von Escolar x Rohdiamant x De Niro bringt GLOCK's Energy nicht nur frisches Blut in die niederländische Zucht, sondern zusätzlich auch einmal mehr die Verbindung mit dem wichtigen Rubinsteinblut, das in den Ahnentafeln der GLOCK Hengste häufig aufscheint. Hoch interessant ist auch die Präsenz der Vollblut- und Anglo-Araber-Hengste, die Nachkommen bis Grand Prix-Niveau brachten. So z.B. Inshallah AA, Prince Thatch xx oder Angelo xx, der Vater von Amon und Ahlerich, welcher unter dem unvergessenen Dr. Rainer Klimke hoch erfolgreich war.

Die Mutter von GLOCK's Energy, Darina (Züchter: Hubert Ratermann), stammt aus dem Stutenstamm der Colona, aus dem berühmte Dressurpferde wie Rubens v. Rubinstein hervorgegangen sind. Sie lieferte mit ihren Söhnen Schneefuß und seinem Vollbruder, dem viel zu früh verstorbenen Kilian (beide v. Sir Donnerhall), bereits drei gekörte Söhne.

Sein Vater Escamillo v. Escolar-Rohdiamant gilt seit seiner Körung in Verden 2017 als eines der auffälligsten Nachwuchsdressurpferde Deutschlands. Der Rheinländer Hengst war der erste Escolar-Sohn, der den Ring als Prämienhengst verließ. 2020 siegte er beim Sporttest in Verden mit einer dressurbetonten Endnote von 9,36 Punkten, 2021 legte er mit der Silbermedaille bei den Weltmeisterschaften der jungen Dressurpferde in Verden einen erneuten Beweis seines Talents im Dressurviereck ab, welchen er 2022 mit dem dritten Rang (83,072 %) bei den siebenjährigen Dressurpferden unterstrich.

GLOCK's Energy holte bei der Hengstleistungsprüfung 2022 in Warendorf insgesamt 7,86 Punkte und wurde auch für Oldenburg anerkannt. 2023 erreichte er bei der Sportprüfung in Münster-Handorf 8,31 Punkte, bei der FEI WBFSH Dressur Weltmeisterschaft für junge Dressurpferde erreichte er das Finale der Vierjährigen und belegte mit 82,80% den sechsten Platz.





# GLOCK'S JOHNSON TN





Zowel in de sport als in de fokkerij heeft GLOCK's Johnson TN bewezen tot de absolute wereldtop te behoren. In 2005 werd hij gekroond tot de afgetekende kampioen van de KWPN-hengstenkeuring en twee jaar later plaatste hij zich voor de finale van het wereldkampioenschap voor 5-jarige dressuurpaarden in Verden. In 2015 leverde hij een grote bijdrage aan het Nederlandse teamgoud op het EK in Aken en behaalde daar ook nog eens individueel brons. Tijdens de Olympische Spelen van 2016 in Rio de Janeiro bleken GLOCK's Johnson TN en Hans Peter Minderhoud de meest succesvolle Nederlandse combinatie. Daarmee bewees GLOCK's Johnson TN opnieuw een vaste waarde voor het Nederlandse team te zijn. Alles bij elkaar maken zijn afstamming, exterieur, karakter en positieve instelling hem tot een topvererver.

GLOCK's Johnson TN heeft meer dan 30 goedgekeurde zonen, waaronder bij het KWPN: Breezer, Bretton Woods en Firestone. Meer dan 50 van zijn nakomelingen acteren op internationaal Grand Prix-niveau en meerdere nakomelingen hebben de afgelopen jaren deel uitgemaakt van de nationale dressuurkaders, onder andere Hartsuijker, Hexagon's Double Dutch, Boston STH, Ben Johnson DVB en Chocolate Cookie RDP. Nakomeling Hero (GLOCK's Johnson TN x OO Seven) maakte met Devenda Dijkstra deel uit van het Nederlandse dressuurteam in Riesenbeck. In 2016 werd GLOCK's Johnson TN 'keur' verklaard en in 2018 ontving hij het 'preferent' predicaat. In het jaar 2019 werd hij vervolgens uitgeroepen tot 'KWPN Paard van het Jaar'.

Bovendien werd GLOCK's Johnson TN in 2020 de nieuwe nummer één van de WBSFH-ranking, waar hij zijn vader Jazz achter zich liet. Ook in 2022 en 2023 stond hij bovenaan in deze ranglijst van meest succesvolle dekhengsten en in 2019 en 2021 werd hij als tweede WBFSH-vererver genoteerd.

GLOCK's Johnson TN is een zoon van de wereldberoemde hengst Jazz, die zelf op Grand Prix-niveau zeer succesvol was. Moedersvader Flemmingh staat bekend als een topvererver, van hem stammen onder andere Krack C en Edward Gal's beroemde hengst Lingham af. GLOCK's Johnson TN stamt af van de beroemde "NL-merrieliën 8", ook bekend als de Reina-stam. Dit is één van de belangrijkste moederlijnen van Nederland met toppaarden als Drakdream, Sultan, Mendel, Charmeur en Waldo in de stamboom.

GLOCK's Johnson TN has proven in sports and breeding that he belongs to the world's best. He won the 2005 KWPN Stallion Show and was finalist in the 2007 World Dressage Championships for Young Horses. He was a major contributor to Dutch team's gold at the 2015 European Championships in Aachen and won an individual bronze medal. At the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, GLOCK's Johnson TN and Hans Peter Minderhoud finished as the top-ranked Dutch duo. Therefore, GLOCK's Johnson TN proved once again that he is a crucial component of the Dutch team. His pedigree, conformation, character and attitude in competition make him a top source of traits.

GLOCK's Johnson TN has 38 KWPN-licensed sons including Breezer, Bretton Woods and Firestone. More than 50 of his progeny perform at international Grand Prix level and several offspring were included in the national dressage teams over the last years, including Hartsuijker, Hexagon's Double Dutch, Boston STH Ben Johnson DVB and Chocolate Cookie RDP. Offspring Hero (GLOCK's Johnson TN x OO Seven) was part of the Dutch dressage team in Riesenbeck with Devenda Dijkstra. In 2016, GLOCK's Johnson TN was awarded the title of "keur", in 2018 the title "preferent" and, in 2019, he was awarded the title of "KWPN Stallion of the Year".

Moreover, in 2020 GLOCK's Johnson TN became the new number one in the WBSFH rankings, where he overtook his sire Jazz. Also in 2022 and 2023, he topped this ranking of most successful stallions and, in 2019 and 2021, he was listed as the second WBSFH sire.

GLOCK's Johnson TN is a son of the renowned Jazz, who was successful up to Grand Prix level. Damsire Flemmingh has earned a great reputation for breeding, having produced Krack C and Edward Gal's famous stallion Lingham, to name but two. GLOCK's Johnson TN goes back to the famous "NL-merrielijs 8", also known as the Reina line. This ranks among the most important dam lines in the Netherlands, including such world-famous horses as Darkdream, Sultan, Mendel, Charmeur and Waldo in its pedigree.



GLOCK's Johnson TN hat in Sport und Zucht bewiesen, dass er zur Weltspitze gehört. Er wurde 2005 KWPN Körsieger und stand 2007 im Finale der Weltmeisterschaft der jungen Dressurpferde. Bei der EM in Aachen 2015 trug er zu Team-Gold der Niederlande bei und holte Bronze im Einzelbewerb. Bei den Olympischen Spielen in Rio de Janeiro 2016 waren GLOCK's Johnson TN und Hans Peter Minderhoud das erfolgreichste niederländische Paar. Damit hat GLOCK's Johnson TN einmal mehr bewiesen, dass er ein bedeutendes Mitglied im niederländischen Team ist. Sein Pedigree, Exterieur, Charakter und seine sportliche Einstellung machen ihn zum Spitzenvererber.

GLOCK's Johnson TN hat 38 KWPN-gekörte Söhne, darunter die niederländisch gezogenen Hengste Breezer, Bretton Woods und Firestone. Mehr als 50 seiner Nachkommen werden auf internationalem Grand-Prix-Niveau vorgestellt und mit Hartsuijker, Hexagon's Double Dutch, Boston STH, Ben Johnson DVB sowie Chocolate Cookie RDP wurden mehrere Nachkommen in den letzten Jahren in den niederländischen Dressurkader aufgenommen. Sein Sohn Hero (GLOCK's Johnson TN x OO Seven) war mit Devenda Dijkstra Teil des niederländischen Dressurteams in Riesenbeck.

2016 wurde GLOCK's Johnson TN mit dem Prädikat „keur“ ausgezeichnet, 2018 mit dem Titel „preferent“ und im Jahr 2019 erhielt er den Titel „KWPN Hengst des Jahres“. Außerdem wurde GLOCK's Johnson TN im Jahr 2020 die neue Nummer eins in der WBSFH-Rangliste, wo er seinen Vater Jazz überholte. Auch 2022 und 2023 stand er an der Spitze dieser Rangliste der erfolgreichsten Hengste und in den Jahren 2019 und 2021 wurde er an zweiter Stelle der WBSFH-Vererberrangliste geführt.

GLOCK's Johnson TN ist ein Sohn des berühmten Jazz, der ebenfalls auf Grand Prix Niveau erfolgreich war. Muttervater Flemmingh ist als herausragender Vererber bestens bekannt, von ihm stammen unter anderem Krack C oder Edward Gals berühmter Hengst Ligh. GLOCK's Johnson TN geht auf die berühmte „NL-merrieliijn 8“ zurück, die auch als Reina-Stamm bekannt ist. Sie zählt zu den bedeutendsten Mutterlinien der Niederlande und kann weltbekannte Pferde wie Drakdream, Sultan, Mendel, Charmeur oder Waldo im Pedigree vorweisen.





# GLOCK'S LONDON



Zowel in de sport als in de fokkerij heeft GLOCK's London zijn sporen ruimschoots verdiend. Onder topruiter Gerco Schröder heeft deze machtige BWP-voshengst vele successen op het hoogste niveau weten te behalen. Hoogtepunten waren de beide zilveren medailles, zowel individueel als met het team op de Olympische Spelen van 2012 in Londen. Daarbovenop kwam een gouden plak met het Nederlandse team op de Wereldruiterspelen in Caen. Succesvol in vele landenwedstrijden, was GLOCK's London van ongekende waarde voor de Nederlandse springsport. Hij wordt dan ook terecht beschouwd als één van de beste springpaarden ter wereld.

De in België gefokte hengst werd in 2002 geboren onder de naam Carembar de Muze. In zijn stamboom zijn vier springhengsten van internationale klasse indrukwekkend gecombineerd. Zijn vader, Selle Français topvererfer Nabab de Reve, was onder Philippe Le Jeune (BEL) succesvol in de topsport. Moeder Ta Belle van Sombeke heeft als vader de Holsteiner hengst Chin Chin, hij was onder Jaime Azcarraga (MEX) een succesvolle Olympiër. Aan moederszijde vinden we Rheinländer Goliath Z (vader van Grosso Z) en de Hannoveraanse Widukind de Lauzelle, die onder Eric Wauters (BEL) één van de meest succesvolle springpaarden van zijn generatie was. Zijn moeder Ta Belle van Sombeke (van Chin Chin x Goliath Z) was onder Jos Lansink eveneens succesvol en bracht meerdere op Grand Prix-springpaarden voort.

Ondanks zijn beperkte inzet in de fokkerij vanwege de sport, heeft GLOCK's London al veel goeds voortgebracht. Daaronder de KWPN gekeurde 'I Am London Apple', London Z, Come to London, Z7 Ipswich (voorheen van de Wolfsakker), die onder Shane Breen zeer succesvol is.

Calourina PS was de veilingtopper op de PSI Auktion in december 2019 en werd voor een bedrag van maar liefst 1,6 miljoen euro naar Frankrijk verkocht. Dit resultaat werd recentelijk overtroffen door de verkoop van Londina PS bij de PSI Auktion voor een bedrag van bijna 2 miljoen euro. Via de PSI Auktion werden alleen al in 2021 voor een bedrag van ruim 3,5 miljoen euro aan nakomelingen van GLOCK's London verkocht. In 2023 maakte nakomeling Oak Grove's Laith met Samuel Hutton deel uit van het Britse team op het EK springen in Milaan.

GLOCK's London has proven his world-leading position in both sport and breeding. Under exceptional Dutch rider Gerco Schröder, this magnificent BWP chestnut stallion achieved a great deal of success at the highest level of show jumping. Top sporting highlights were the two silver medals, individual and team, at the 2012 Olympic Games in London (GBR), along with a gold medal with the Dutch team at the World Equestrian Games in Caen (FRA). Moreover, GLOCK's London achieved great triumphs in Rio de Janeiro (BRA), Cannes (FRA), Doha (QAT), Vienna (AUT) and Aachen (GER) and does indeed count among the best show jumping horses in the world.

This Belgian-bred stallion was born in 2002 and named Carembar de Muze. His pedigree combines four international show jumping stallions. His sire, the Selle Français top breeding stallion Nabab de Reve, was successful in top-class sport under Philippe Le Jeune (BEL), whilst the sire of his dam, Holsteiner Chin Chin, had Olympic success under Jaime Azcarraga (MEX). On his dam's side were the Rhenish Goliath Z (sire of Grosso Z) and the powerfully jumping Hanoverian Widukind de Lauzelle. His dam Ta Belle van Sombeke, the successful show-jumping mare under Jos Lansink, delivered several successful show jumping horses at Grand Prix level.

Notwithstanding limited breeding engagements due to sport, GLOCK's London has produced successful offspring, including his KWPN-approved son 'I Am London Apple', London Z, Come to London Z and Z7 Ipswich (formerly van de Wolfsakker), the latter highly successful under Shane Breen. His daughter Calourina PS was the auction topper at the PSI Auction in December 2019 and was sold to France for no less than 1.6 million euros. This result was recently surpassed by the sale of Londina PS via the PSI Auction for almost 2 million euros. Offspring of GLOCK's London were sold for more than 3.5 million euros through the PSI Auction in 2021 alone. In 2023, offspring Oak Grove's Laith with Samuel Hutton was part of the British team at the European Jumping Championships in Milan.





GLOCK's London hat in Sport und Zucht seine Weltspitze bewiesen. Unter Ausnahmereiter Gerco Schröder erzielte der prächtige Fuchshengst weltweit Erfolge. Highlights waren die Silbermedaillen im Einzel und Team bei den Olympischen Spielen (London 2012) sowie Team-Gold bei den Weltreiterspielen in Caen. Darüber hinaus feierte GLOCK's London in Rio de Janeiro, Cannes, Doha, Wien oder Aachen große Triumphe, war mit seiner außergewöhnlichen Leistungsbereitschaft und Sprunggewalt bei Nationenpreisen stets ein Fels in der Brandung und zählt zu den besten Springpferden der Welt.

Der belgisch gezogene Hengst wurde als Carembar de Muze geboren. In seinem Pedigree sind vier Top-Springhengste eindrucksvoll kombiniert: Sein Vater, Selle Français-Spitzenvererber Nabab de Reve, sein Holsteiner-Muttervater Chin Chin sowie mütterlicherseits der Rheinländer Goliath Z (Vater des Grosso Z) und der Hannoveraner Widukind de Lauzelle. Seine Mutter Tabelle van Sombeke (von Chin Chin x Goliath Z) feierte große Erfolge unter Jos Lansink und brachte mehrere erfolgreiche Springpferde auf Grand-Prix-Level hervor.

GLOCK's London kann trotz selektiven Zuchteinsatzes aufgrund seiner Sportkarriere auf erfolgreiche Nachkommen verweisen. Bis heute sind über 200 Nachkommen erfasst, darunter sein KWPN-gekörter Sohn I Am London Apple oder London Z, Come to London Z oder Z7 Ipswich (vormals van de Wolfsakker), der unter Shane Breen hoch erfolgreich ist. Im Dezember 2020 war seine Tochter Calourina PS mit 1,6 Mio. Euro der Top-Seller der PSI Auktion. Übertroffen wurde dieses Ergebnis durch den Verkauf von Londina PS über die PSI Auktion für knapp 2 Millionen Euro. Alleine 2021 wurden über die PSI Auktion Nachkommen von GLOCK's London für mehr als 3,5 Millionen Euro versteigert. 2023 gehörte sein Nachkomme Oak Grove's Laith zusammen mit Samuel Hutton zum britischen Team bei den Europameisterschaften im Springreiten in Mailand.



# GLOCK'S PABLO PICASSO



GLOCK's Pablo Picasso is een opvallende zoon van GLOCK's Taminiau, uit een merrie van Florencio x Farrington. Hij was als veulen al een echte eyecatcher en wist ook op de KWPN Hengstenkeuring 2023 publiek en keuringscommissie te overtuigen, waar hij tevens werd uitgeroepen tot KWPN premiehengst. Deze bloedmooie voshengst is gefokt door Ben Mensinck en Marjolein Ras (NL) en overtuigt met zijn ruime gangen, elasticiteit, knie-actie, hengstenuitstraling, werkwillegheid en imponerende uiterlijk.

Het KWPN verrichtingsonderzoek wist GLOCK's Pablo Picasso in december 2023 af te sluiten met een totaal van 80 punten. De jury roemde zijn betrouwbaarheid, looplust en werkwillegheid. "Zijn stap is zuiver en goed van ruimte en lichaamsgebruik. De draf is actief met een goede beentechniek. De galop is goed tot zeer goed van ruimte, krachtig en gedragen. GLOCK's Pablo Picasso heeft in beweging ruim voldoende souplesse en veel houding en balans. Als dressuurpaard heeft hij veel aanleg en geeft zijn ruiter een goed tot zeer goed gevoel."

Zijn vader, GLOCK's Taminiau (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Sandro Hit x Carprilli), behaalde een topscore tijdens het KWPN-verrichtingsonderzoek, met maar liefst een negen voor zijn stap en galop en een acht voor de draf. Tijdens de 70-daagse test liet hij zien over een zeer werkwilleg karakter en hetzelfde talent als zijn eigen vader, GLOCK's Toto Jr. én diens vader Totilas, te beschikken. GLOCK's Taminiau wist, met punten die nooit onder de 9,5 kwamen, de KWPN Hengstencompetitie te winnen met een overtuigend totaal van 92 punten. Dit succes blijft hij voortzetten, want ook tijdens zijn internationale debuut kon GLOCK's Taminiau het oranje lint in ontvangst nemen.

Grootvader GLOCK's Toto Jr. is de eerste KWPN-goedgekeurde zoon van de legendarische hengst Totilas, die onder Edward Gal drievoudig Wereldkampioen wist te worden. Zij wisten wereldrecords te breken en ook zorgden ze voor een ongekende populariteit van de dressuursport wereldwijd.

Grootvader van moederskant is de Duits gefokte KWPN keurhengst Florencio I (Florestan I x Weltmeyer x Pikbube II), welke zich ontwikkelende tot stempelhengst in de Duitse en Nederlandse dressuurfokkerij. Hij tekent voor het vaderschap van 44 goedgekeurde zonen en 54 staatspremie merries. Onder GLOCK ruiter Hans Peter Minderhoud werd Florencio I in 2004 en 2005 de overtuigende winnaar van het Wereldkampioenschap Jonge Dressuurpaarden in het Duitse Verden.

GLOCK's Pablo Picasso by GLOCK's Taminiau, out of a dam by Florencio x Farrington, was already an eye-catcher as a foal and showed this also as a two-year-old in front of the Dutch licensing commission 2022, which awarded him the distinction of KWPN premium stallion. This wonderful liver chestnut was bred by Ben Mensick and Marjolein Ras (NL) and impressed with his ground-covering gaits, movements full of elasticity, great knee action, his stallion characteristics and excellent conformation and nature.

GLOCK's Pablo Picasso succeeded in completing the KWPN performance test in December 2023 with a total of 80 points. The judges praised his consistency, enthusiasm and attitude. "His walk is clean with good ground cover and physicality. The trot is active with good leg technique. The canter is good to very good in ground cover, powerful and supple. GLOCK's Pablo Picasso has ample suppleness in motion and plenty of posture and balance. As a dressage horse he has a lot of talent and gives his rider a good feeling."

His sire, GLOCK's Taminiau by GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Sandro Hit x Carprilli, scored top marks at his KWPN stallion performance test, receiving nine points for walk and canter and eight points for trot. During the 70-day test, he demonstrated the greatest willingness to perform and that same talent and rideability displayed by his own sire, GLOCK's Toto Jr., and his grandsire, the legendary Totilas. GLOCK's Taminiau never scored below 9.5 points in the KWPN stallion test and finished with 92 points as the winner. He continued his success after a sensational development and leaving the arena as the winner on his international debut.

Grandsire GLOCK's Toto Jr. is the first KWPN-licensed son of the legendary Totilas who, under Edward Gal, was a three-time World Champion, broke world records, led the dressage sport to unprecedented popularity and also set breeding records. GLOCK's Pablo Picasso's damsire Florencio I (by Florestan I x Weltmeyer x Pikbube II) is the top Westphalian sire and stamp stallion of German breeding, having produced over 44 licensed sons and 54 state premium mares. Under GLOCK Rider Hans Peter Minderhoud, he was named World Champion of Young Dressage Horses in both 2004 and 2005.



GLOCK's Pablo Picasso von GLOCK's Taminiau aus einer Mutter von Florencio x Farrington war schon als Fohlen ein Eyecatcher und zeigte dies auch als Zweijähriger vor der niederländische Körkommission 2022, die ihn zum KWPN-Prämienhengst adelte. Der wundervolle Dunkelfuchs mit der auffallend blonden Mähne stammt aus der Zucht von Ben Mensick und Marjolein Ras (NL) und beeindruckte mit raumgreifenden Grundgangarten bei schwingvoller Elastizität, toller Knieaktion, seinem besonderen Hengsttyp und einem hervorragenden Ex- und Interieur.

Die KWPN-Leistungsprüfung konnte GLOCK's Pablo Picasso im Dezember 2023 mit einer Gesamtpunktzahl von 80 Punkten abschließen. Die Richter lobten seine Beständigkeit, seine Freude an der Bewegung und seine Einstellung. „Sein Schritt ist rein und mit gutem Raumgriff und Körpereinsatz. Der Trab ist aktiv mit guter Beintechnik. Der Galopp ist gut bis sehr gut im Raumgriff, kraftvoll und getragen. GLOCK's Pablo Picasso ist sehr geschmeidig in der Bewegung und verfügt über eine sehr gute Körperhaltung und Balance. Als Dressurpferd hat er viel Talent und gibt seinem Reiter ein gutes Gefühl“.

Sein Vater GLOCK's Taminiau v. GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Sandro Hit x Carprilli punktete bei seinem KWPN-Hengstleistungstest mit Bestnoten, bekam für Schritt und Galopp neun und für den Trab acht Punkte. Während des 70-Tage-Tests zeigte er höchste Leistungsbereitschaft, ebensolches Talent und beste Rittigkeit, die auch schon seinen eigenen Vater GLOCK's Toto Jr. und seinen Großvater, den legendären Totilas, ausmachten. GLOCK's Taminiau erhielt bei der KWPN-Hengstprüfung keine Note unter 9,5 Punkten und beendete die Prüfung mit 92 Punkten als Sieger. Den Erfolg setzte er nach einer sensationellen Entwicklung fort und ging bei seinem internationalen Debut als Sieger aus dem Viereck.

Großvater GLOCK's Toto Jr. ist der erste für KWPN gekörte Sohn des legendären Totilas, der unter Edward Gal dreifacher Weltmeister war, Weltrekorde brach, den Dressursport zu einer ungeahnten Popularität führte und auch züchterisch Bestmarken setzte.

GLOCK's Pablo Picassos Muttervater Florencio I (v. Florestan I x Weltmeyer x Pikkube II) ist ein westfälischer Top-Vererber und Stempelhengst deutscher Zucht, der über 44 gekörte Söhne und 54 Staatsprämienstuten hervorbrachte. Unter GLOCK Rider Hans Peter Minderhoud wurde er sowohl 2004 als auch 2005 zum Weltmeister der jungen Dressurpferde gekürt.

Like his sire, GLOCK's Toto Jr., his grandsire, Totilas, and his great-grandsire, Gribaldi, GLOCK's Taminiau exhibits fine posture, with a gleaming black coat and a dash of white on each leg. With GLOCK's Taminiau (GLOCK's Toto Jr. - Sandro Hit - Carprilli), GLOCK's Toto Jr. (Totilas - Desperados - Rotspon) delivered his first son for the traditional Hanoverian stallion licensing of 2017. There, GLOCK's Taminiau gave him every reason for pride. This elegant stallion presented himself contained with well-balanced movements and three extraordinary basic gaits. He left the licensing ground with a positive result and was additionally honored with the title of premium stallion.

GLOCK's Taminiau also passed the KWPN stallion performance test with top marks, receiving nine points for walk and canter. During the 70-day test he demonstrated the highest levels of willingness to perform, with corresponding talent and rideability. GLOCK's Taminiau made a big impression during the stallion competition. In the selections he scored no lower than a 9.5 for his gaits and he continued in this vein in the 2021/2022 KWPN Stallion Competition finals. In addition to the very high marks for his gaits, his talent as a dressage horse was also rated at 9.5. In 2022, this handsome black stallion won the KWPN stallion test and was the standout winner with 92 points. GLOCK's Taminiau also won his international debut in the Small Tour.

His sire, GLOCK's Toto Jr., is the first KWPN-licensed son of the legendary Totilas. His damsire, Sandro Hit, has contributed outstanding hereditary performance, and is the sire of Olympic medal winners. His grandsire Totilas was a three-times World Champion, broke three world records, raised dressage sport to previously unimagined levels of popularity and achieved top marks in terms of breeding.

The foals of GLOCK's Taminiau are long-legged with expressive gaits and elegant head. With his outstanding leg technique, strength of movement, rideability and attitude, GLOCK's Taminiau is set to make an ideal contribution to bringing new blood to the dressage breeding scene. At auctions, there is a lot of international interest in the very well-moving and stunning foals from GLOCK's Taminiau, which translates into high prices. With Onyx (GLOCK's Taminiau x Uphill), GLOCK's Taminiau provided the winner of the KWPN Online Stallion Auction in January 2022. With his charming appearance, his son, Pablo Picasso out of a Florencio dam, was one of the most striking stallions of the 2023 stallion selection and therefore designated for the KWPN performance test and declared a premium stallion. GLOCK's Pablo Picasso succeeded in completing the KWPN performance test in December 2023 with a total of 80 points.



Wie sein Vater GLOCK's Toto Jr., sein Großvater Totilas, und sein Urgroßvater Gribaldi, zeigt sich GLOCK's Taminiau von edler Körperhaltung, in lackschwarzer Weste mit viermal Weiß an den Beinen. Mit GLOCK's Taminiau (GLOCK's Toto Jr. – Sandro Hit – Caprilli) stellte GLOCK's Toto Jr. (Totilas – Desperados – Rotspon) bei der traditionellen Hannoveraner Hengstkörung 2017 seinen ersten Sohn. Dort machte ihm GLOCK's Taminiau alle Ehre. Der schicke Hengst zeigte sich gut geschlossen, mit ausbalancierter Bewegung und drei überragenden Grundgangarten. Er verließ den Körring mit positivem Körurteil und wurde zusätzlich als Premiumhengst geadelt.

Auch den KWPN Hengstleistungstest bestand GLOCK's Taminiau mit Bestnoten, bekam für Schritt und Galopp neun Punkte und für den Trab acht Punkte. Während des 70-Tage-Tests zeigte er höchste Leistungsbereitschaft, ebensolches Talent und beste Rittigkeit. GLOCK's Taminiau verließ mit Noten, die nie unter 9,5 lagen, die KWPN Hengstprüfung mit 92 Punkten als Sieger. GLOCK's Taminiau setzte diesen Erfolg auch in der KWPN Hengstprüfung 2021/2022 fort. Neben den sehr guten Noten für die Grundgangarten wurde auch seine Dressuranlage mit einer 9,5 bewertet. 2022 entschied der schicke Rappe die KWPN Hengstprüfung für sich und war mit 92 Punkten herausragender Sieger, sein internationales Debut in der Kleinen Tour gewann er ebenfalls.

Sein Vater GLOCK's Toto Jr. ist der erste für KWPN gekörte Sohn des legendären Totilas. Muttervater Sandro Hit gilt als Veredler mit epochaler Vererbungsleistung und ist Vater vieler olympischer Medallenträger. Großvater Totilas war unter Edward Gal dreifacher Weltmeister, brach drei Weltrekorde, führte den Dressursport zu einer ungeahnten Popularität und setzt auch züchterisch Bestmarken.

Die Fohlen von GLOCK's Taminiau zeigen sich langbeinig, mit ausdruckstarken Gängen und edlem Kopf. Mit seiner hervorragenden Beintechnik, Bewegungsstärke, Rittigkeit und Einstellung kann GLOCK's Taminiau einen idealen Beitrag zur Blutauffrischung in der Dressurpferdezucht leisten. Auf Auktionen ist das Interesse an den bewegungsstarken und bildschönen Fohlen von GLOCK's Taminiau international bereits sehr groß, was sich in hohen Preisen für seinen Nachwuchs niederschlägt. Mit Onyx (GLOCK's Taminiau x Uphill) stellte GLOCK's Taminiau im Jänner 2022 den Sieger der KWPN Online Hengstauktion. Sein Sohn Pablo Picasso aus einer Florencio-Mutter war mit seiner charmanten Erscheinung einer der auffälligsten Hengste der Hengstkörung und wurde deshalb zur KWPN-Leistungsprüfung zugelassen und zum Prämienhengst erklärt. Die KWPN-Leistungsprüfung konnte GLOCK's Pablo Picasso im Dezember 2023 mit einer Gesamtpunktzahl von 80 Punkten abschließen.





# GLOCK'S TOTO JR.



GLOCK's Toto Jr. is de eerste goedgekeurde zoon van de legendarische hengst Totilas. In het voorjaar van 2014 won hij het verrichtingsonderzoek in Ermelo met maar liefst 86 punten.

Vanaf het debuut op Grand Prix niveau wisten GLOCK's Toto Jr. en Edward Gal altijd scores rond de 80% en hoger te behalen. Niet gek dat hij in december 2020 dan ook uitgeroepen werd tot FEI Paard van de Maand. GLOCK's Toto Jr. overtuigt met een uitstekende ruime en zuivere stap, zowel de draf als de galop zijn bergopwaarts, lichtvoetig, in balans en krachtig in afdruk. Ook qua exterieur zit de hengst zeer goed in elkaar. Al deze kenmerken en ook zijn ongecompliceerde karakter worden door GLOCK's Toto Jr. doorgegeven aan zijn nakomelingen, wat dan ook resulteerde in een zeer positief veulenrapport.

De nakomelingen van GLOCK's Toto Jr. zijn zeer geliefd en brengen de afgelopen jaren op verschillende veilingen hoge bedragen op. Voor de eerste bezichtiging van de KWPN Hengstenkeuring in 2021 werden totaal 24 zonen van GLOCK's Toto Jr. aangemeld, hiervan werden er 8 direct aangewezen voor de tweede bezichtiging. In 2022 werden zijn zonen O'Toto van de Wimphof en Hexagon's Gorgeous Black na deelname aan het KWPN verrichtingsonderzoek, goedgekeurd. Maar liefst vier van de zes zonen werden op de KWPN Hengstenkeuring 2023 in Den Bosch aangewezen voor het verrichtingsonderzoek.


Naast GLOCK's Taminiau, GLOCK's King Karim, Blue Hors Kingston, Mister Maserati, Newport, O'Toto van de Wimphof en Hexagon's Gorgeous Black is het aantal goedgekeurde zonen in 2023 toegenomen tot meer dan 40. Ook de dochters van GLOCK's Toto Jr. doen het niet onverdienstelijk. In 2022 was hij hoofdleverancier bij de IBOP voor dressuurmerries, er namen zeventien nakomelingen deel waarvan er maar liefst dertien slaagden voor de test. Bovendien leverde GLOCK's Toto Jr. ook de meeste nakomelingen die in 2023 deelnamen aan de Pavo Cup. Met als uitspringer Mac Toto USB (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Jazz) die onder Daniëlle Heijkoop bij de zesjarigen met overmacht won.

Ook bij het WK jonge paarden waren de nakomelingen van GLOCK's Toto Jr. goed vertegenwoordigd. Bij de zesjarigen was het My Toto (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Voice) die met Hans Peter Minderhoud bovenaan eindigde en het wereldkampioenschap op naam kon schrijven. Waarbij in dezelfde leeftijdscategorie GLOCK's Massimo (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Bretton Woods) en Hexagon's Miamanda (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Hexagon's Rubiquil) zich ook plaatsten voor de finale.

De moeder van GLOCK's Toto Jr., Desperada, is een dochter van Desperados, die in 2015 twee zilveren medailles won in Aken op de Europese kampioenschappen. Zowel de moeder als de grootmoeder van GLOCK's Toto Jr. hebben uitstekende prestatietests in Duitsland afgelegd en werden door de testruiters beoordeeld met het maximale cijfer voor rijdbaarheid, een 10!

GLOCK's Toto Jr. is the first licensed son of the legendary Totilas. At the age of three he won his stallion performance test in Ermelo with 86 points. Since their debut at Grand Prix level, GLOCK's Toto Jr. and Edward Gal have always scored around 80% and above. In 2020 he was the big winner of the Dutch Dressage Championships with a score of no less than 86.15% in the freestyle and was chosen FEI Horse of the Month in December 2020. He shows excellent ground cover in the walk, his trot and canter impress with power, lightness, elasticity, balance and uphill tendency. This magnificent black stallion also exhibits outstanding qualities of conformation and nature. These characteristics are passed on to his offspring, evident in his very impressive foal report.

His offspring are very popular and have achieved high prices at various auctions over recent years. A total of 24 sons of GLOCK's Toto Jr. were entered for the first round viewing at the KWPN Stallion Show in 2021 and eight of them were immediately selected for the second round viewing. No fewer than four of the six sons were at the KWPN Stallion Show 2023 in Den Bosch, selected for the performance test.

In addition to GLOCK's Taminiau, GLOCK's King Karim, Blue Hors Kingston, Mister Maserati, Newport, O'Toto van de Wimphof and Hexagon's Gorgeous Black, the number of approved sons in 2023 has increased to over 40. The daughters of GLOCK's Toto Jr. are also doing well. In 2022 he was the main supplier at the IBOP for dressage mares, with seventeen offspring taking part and thirteen of them passing the test. In addition, GLOCK's Toto Jr. also produced the most offspring competing in the Pavo Cup in 2023. The standout is Mac Toto USB (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Jazz) who, under Daniëlle Heijkoop, won by a substantial margin in the six-year-olds.

The offspring of GLOCK's Toto Jr. were also well represented at the World Championships for young horses. In the six-year-olds it was My Toto (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Voice) who came top with Hans Peter Minderhoud and won the World Championships. In the same age group, GLOCK's Massimo (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Bretton Woods) and Hexagons Miamanda (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Hexagon's Rubiquil) also qualified for the final.

His dam, Desperada, is descended from Desperados, who twice achieved individual silver medals at the 2015 European Championships in Aachen. Both his dam and granddam finished their mare performance tests in Germany with excellent scores: test riders gave them the maximum 10.0 for rideability.

GLOCK's Toto Jr. überzeugt durch einen exzellenten, weiträumigen und sauberen Schritt. Im Trab und Galopp besticht er durch Ausdrucksstärke, Leichtfüßigkeit und starke Bergauf-Tendenz. Der bewegungsstarke Rappe ist sowohl vom Exterieur als auch vom Interieur her top ausgestattet. All diese Eigenschaften samt seinem unkomplizierten Charakter gibt der Totilas-Sohn an seine Nachkommen weiter, was sich in seinem äußerst positiven Fohlenreport zeigt.

Die Nachkommen von GLOCK's Toto Jr. sind sehr begehrt und haben in den letzten Jahren auf diversen Auktionen hohe Summen erzielt. Zur ersten Besichtigung der KWPN Hengstkörung 2021 wurden insgesamt 24 Söhne von GLOCK's Toto Jr. registriert, acht davon wurden sofort für die zweite Besichtigung selektiert. GLOCK's Toto Jr. stellte auch die meisten Nachkommen, die 2023 am Pavo Cup teilnahmen. Herausragend ist Mac Toto USB (GLOCK's Toto Jr. x Jazz), der unter Daniëlle Heijkoop bei den Sechsjährigen mit großem Abstand gewann.

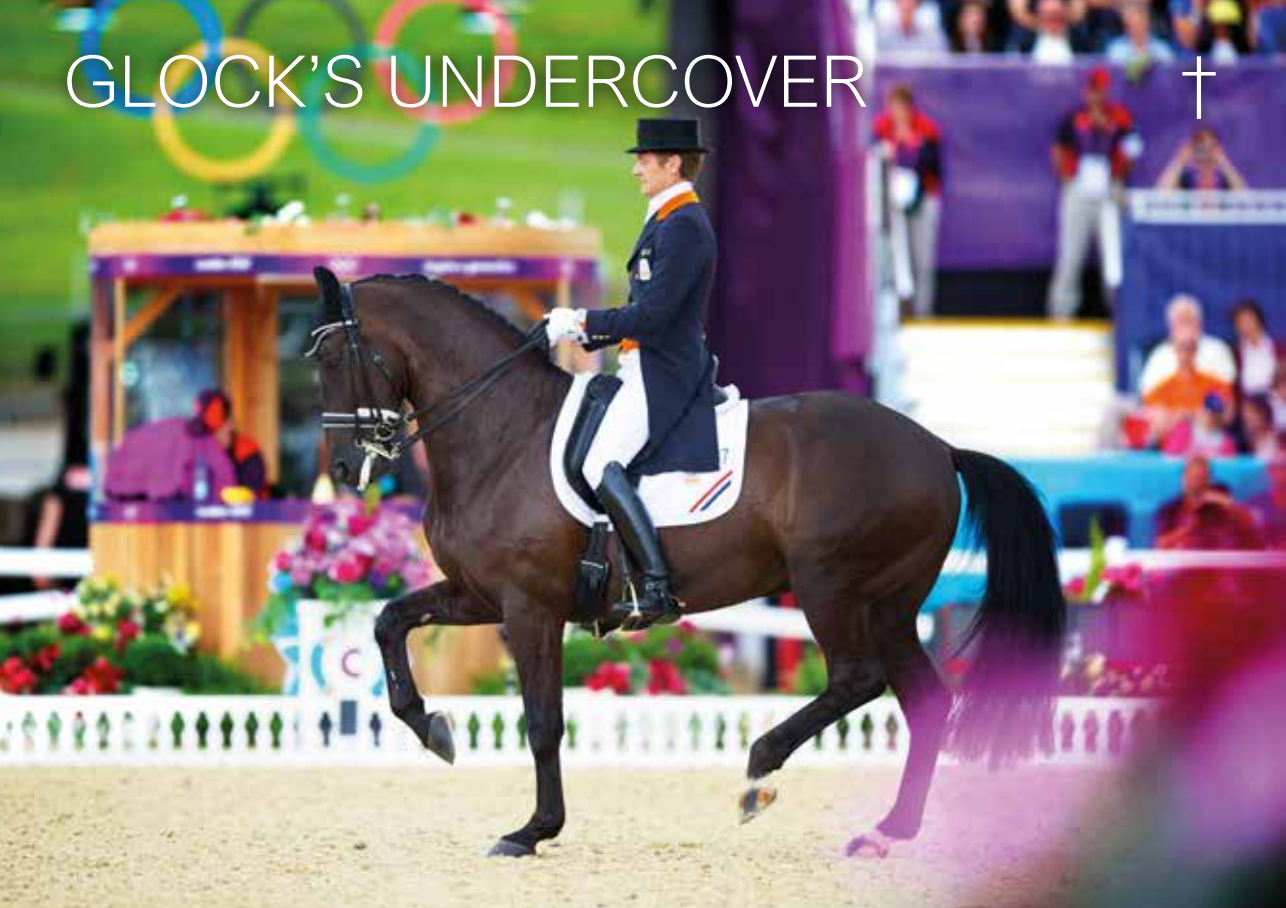

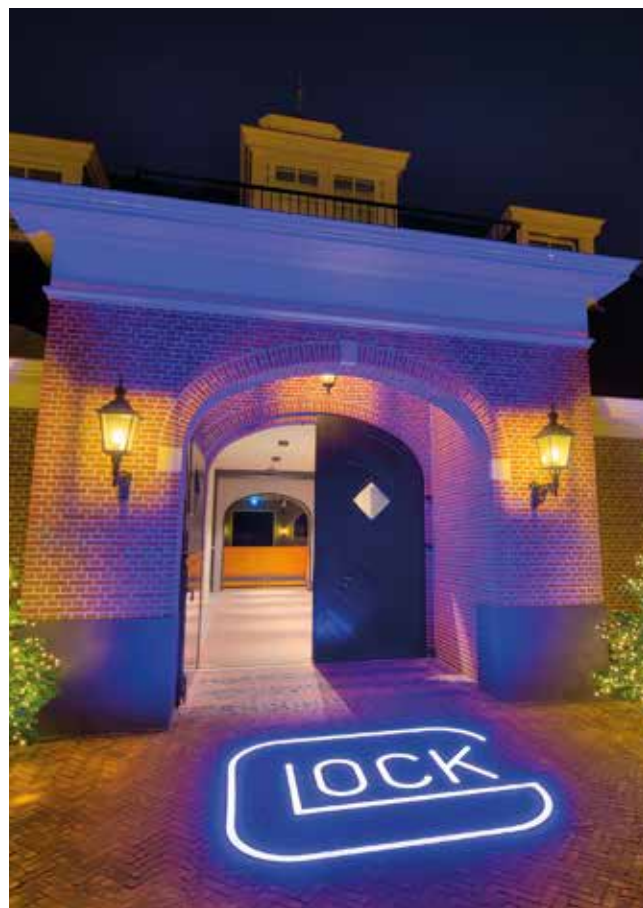

# Stud Conditions of GLOCK Stallions B.V.

## Article 1 - General

1.1 These Stud Terms and Conditions apply to all breeding contracts, offers (including but not exclusively via advertisements and/or brochures) and assignments between GLOCK Stallions as stallion owner, hereinafter called 'GLOCK Stallions' and the proprietor/owner of the mare to be inseminated, hereinafter to be called the 'Mare Owner'.

1.2 If the contract is made at a distance with a Mare Owner who is a Consumer, the text of these Terms and Conditions will be sent electronically to the Consumer in such manner that the Consumer can easily store the Terms and Conditions on a permanent data carrier. If this is not reasonably possible, before the Contract is made at a distance, it will be indicated where the Terms and Conditions can be inspected electronically and that on the Consumer's request they can be sent electronically or some other way free of charge.

1.3 The breeding contract between GLOCK Stallions and the Mare Owner is a contract for services as referred to in Title 7 Book 7 of the Dutch Civil Code (DCC). The obligation which GLOCK Stallions takes on with regard to the Mare Owner, is an obligation of endeavours and thus not an obligation of results.

1.4 Deviations from these general terms and conditions are only applicable if they have been agreed in writing between GLOCK Stallions and the Mare Owner.

1.5 If deviations from these Stud Terms and Conditions have been agreed, the Mare Owner cannot derive any rights therefrom with regard to future agreements with GLOCK Stallions.

1.6 If a (part of a) provision of these Terms and Conditions is void or voided, the other provisions of these Terms and Conditions will remain in full effect. In addition, the provisions which have been declared void will be replaced by a reasonable alternative.

1.7 GLOCK Stallions will not accept any requests or orders for natural covering, but only for fresh or frozen semen.

1.8 The insemination of the mare is never carried out by GLOCK Stallions, nor by a person acting on instruction of or under the responsibility of GLOCK Stallions. Nor will insemination take place on premises of GLOCK Stallions. Insemination will be carried out by and under the responsibility of the Mare Owner.

1.9 The export procedure for Horses, Horse Semen and Horse Embryos of the Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority applies to the delivery of orders to Mare Owners outside of the Netherlands.

## Article 2 – Special definitions

2.1 Semen: the fluid containing sperm cells produced by the stallions which GLOCK Stallions offers for covering, in these terms also called the 'product'.

2.2 Mare Owner: proprietor and/or owner of a mare which is inseminated by the semen of a stallion made available by GLOCK Stallions.

2.3 CEM infection: Contagious Equine Metritis, contagious uterine inflammation in horses.

2.4 EVA: Equine Viral Arteritis, contagious respiratory disease

2.5 WFFS gene: Warmblood Fragile Foal Syndrome gene, genetic disorder in warmblood foals.

2.6 Stud fee: divided into fixed costs (€ 275 including VAT) and a gestation charge (variable per stallion).

2.7 Non-gestation discount: If a mare is not pregnant at the end of the season (September), the owner can receive a non-gestation discount. The gestation charge part of the stud fee will then be returned. This amount will only be returned if the full stud fee including costs has already been paid.

## Article 3 – Offer

3.1. Any quote and any offer, stallion brochure or advertisement of GLOCK Stallions is without commitment unless otherwise stated.

3.2. Any quote and any offer is valid for a period of 30 days, unless otherwise indicated.

3.3. In the event of a quote or offer which is without commitment, GLOCK Stallions has the right to revoke this quote or offer at latest within 2 working days after receipt of the acceptance. GLOCK Stallions is at all times, for whatever reason, entitled to no longer offer a stallion for covering.

3.4. A quote or offer will lapse if the product to which the quote or the offer relates can no longer be delivered.

3.5. If the acceptance deviates – including on subordinate points – from the provisions in the offer, GLOCK Stallions is not bound by the acceptance. The contract will then not be made in accordance with this deviating acceptance, unless GLOCK Stallions agrees to such in writing.

## Article 4 – Making of the contract

4.1. The contract is made by full acceptance of the offer by the Mare Owner, taking account of Article 3.5.

4.2. Acceptance takes place by the Mare Owner placing an order or request by telephone contact with GLOCK Stallions in the event of a domestic order - this also applies if the Mare Owner has the order placed by means of an agent\*\* - or via [www.ordersemen.com](http://www.ordersemen.com) if the matter concerns an order from outside the Netherlands.

4.3. Only in the case of an electronic order will GLOCK Stallions electronically confirm the receipt of the acceptance of the offer by return. The Mare Owner can revoke his acceptance up to the time of receipt of the acceptance.

4.4. The contract will also be made after GLOCK Stallions has accepted an assignment from the Mare Owner in writing, or if GLOCK Stallions – without objection of the Mare Owner – has started the actual performance of the contract.

## Article 5 – The Mare Owner's duty to provide information

5.1. Prior to the first insemination of the mare, the pedigree and passport details of the mare to be inseminated and the name and address details of the owner of this mare must have been provided to GLOCK Stallions in writing. As long as the Mare Owner does not provide this information, GLOCK Stallions is not obliged to provide the semen.

5.2. In addition, when presenting the mare for first cover/insemination, the Mare Owner must inform GLOCK Stallions about:

- covering and/or inseminations in prior years or the current breeding season, domestically and abroad;
- a possible CEM suspicion in relation to the mare;
- the fact that the mare may be suspected of having other infections which can be transmitted by genital contact.

## Article 6 – Registration of covers and inseminations

GLOCK Stallions is obliged to record all covers or inseminations and all subsequent covers or subsequent inseminations in the manner prescribed by the Studbook.

## Article 7 - Necessary details & processing of personal data

7.1 The Mare Owner consents by accepting these general terms and conditions to have explicitly granted consent for the registration of his personal data – as well as details regarding his mare – by GLOCK Stallions.

7.2 GLOCK Stallions is bound to protect data pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) as of the time that the personal data have come into its possession until the time that the personal data can be destroyed.

7.3 GLOCK Stallions will never share data with third parties without the explicit written consent of the Mare Owner, unless it is obliged to do so under the law or the nature of a specific assignment to GLOCK Stallions makes such necessary.

7.4 During the handling of the matter, the personal data will be held as carefully as possible at the office of GLOCK Stallions and will only be moved if proper handling of the file requires such. If the physical file is located outside of the office of GLOCK Stallions, GLOCK Stallions will take the necessary care to prevent loss or wrongful processing of personal data.

7.5 GLOCK Stallions will store files and personal data both internally and externally during the statutory storage period. GLOCK Stallions will treat the storage and processing of the files carefully. If GLOCK Stallions makes use of third parties for the storage of data, GLOCK Stallions will impose an obligation on the third party to assure at least the same level of security.

7.6 Other information – including the rights of the user - relating to the processing of personal data by GLOCK Stallions is set out in the GLOCK Stallions 'privacy statement'. This privacy statement can be found on the GLOCK Stallions website: [www.ghpc.at/en/at/data-privacy/](http://www.ghpc.at/en/at/data-privacy/).

## Article 8 – Duration of the breeding season

The breeding season runs from 1 March up to and including 15 August of a calendar year. In connection with sporting events, GLOCK Stallions is entitled to deviate from this period.

## Article 9 – Stud fees

9.1 All stud fees are per pregnancy inclusive of VAT, exclusive of transport costs, pedigree costs and other charges and exclusive of costs which GLOCK Stallions makes in the interests of the performance of the contract, unless GLOCK Stallions has indicated otherwise. Costs incurred in relation to the regulations of the Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority are also at the Mare Owner's expense.

9.2 Payment of the entire stud fee and the additional costs and charges must be made immediately upon ordering, or within 14 days after receipt of the invoice.

9.3 After the expiry of the payment term the Mare Owner will be in default. After the expiry of said date, GLOCK Stallions will send a reminder and will give the Mare Owner the opportunity to make payment within 14 days after receipt of this reminder. The Mare Owner will then owe an amount in statutory interest to GLOCK Stallions.

9.4 If payment is still not made after a reminder by GLOCK Stallions, GLOCK Stallions also has the right to charge the Mare Owner extrajudicial debt collection costs. These extrajudicial debt collection costs will be calculated on the basis of the Sliding Scale for Extrajudicial Debt Collection Costs (BIK) pursuant to the Decision on the Standardisation of Debt Collection Costs.

9.5 If the mare is sold after the first or a subsequent insemination, the Mare Owner remains at all times obliged to pay the stud fee.

9.6 If the Mare Owner cancels an order which has been placed in whole or in part, the goods ordered or made ready therefor and the working time reserved for the performance of the contract will be charged to the Mare Owner in full. This provision does not apply if the Mare Owner is a consumer and there is a distance contract as referred to in Article 6:230g(1)(e) DCC.

## Article 10 – Non-gestation discount

The Mare Owner will pay the entire stud fee within the term stipulated in Article 9(2). If the Mare Owner demonstrates by means of a written certificate from a veterinarian at latest on 1 October of the same season that the mare in question is not pregnant, the Mare Owner will be repaid the "gestation charge" part of the stud fee which has been paid + VAT. In the event no such certificate is presented the non-gestation discount will be cancelled.

## Article 11 – More than one foal

11.1 GLOCK Stallions does not sell "separate straws of semen", but only a pregnancy per mare.  
11.2 If several foals were to nevertheless come from one insemination, a stud fee is owed per live born foal.  
11.3 In the event there is a situation as referred to in paragraph 2 of this article, the Mare Owner is obliged to report this to GLOCK Stallions. If the Mare Owner does not perform this obligation, GLOCK Stallions will have a claim on the Mare Owner for the full stud fee which applies in the year of the birth of the foal, without discount.

## Article 12 – Embryo transplant and ICSI

12.1 The use of the (frozen) semen for embryo transplant and/or ICSI is only permitted on appointment.  
12.2 If the Mare Owner orders the semen with the goal of carrying out embryo transplant or ICSI with the semen, the Mare Owner must notify GLOCK Stallions thereof prior to the placing of an order or the making of a request.  
12.3 A stud fee will be charged to the Mare Owner per successful embryo and/or ICSI. The Mare Owner is obliged to notify GLOCK Stallions of the number of successful embryos and/or ICSIs. If the Mare Owner does not perform this obligation, GLOCK Stallions will have a claim on the Mare Owner for the entire stud fee which applied in the year of the birth of the foal/embryo in question, without discount. An embryo or ICSI is deemed successful when a pregnancy lasts at least 9 weeks.  
12.4 The Mare Owner must present GLOCK Stallions with an overview of the number of successful embryos and/or ICSIs per mare which has been prepared and signed by the officially recognised veterinarian of the ET centre before the end of the breeding season. If the embryo transplant or ICSI has not been successful, this overview will be deemed a non-gestation certificate.

## Article 13 – Other provisions regarding (frozen) semen

13.1 Unused straws will at all times remain the property of GLOCK Stallions. In the event a straw is not used, it must be sent back to GLOCK Stallions at the end of the breeding season. The shipping costs of the return shipment are at the Mare Owner's expense.  
13.2 The Mare Owner is never entitled to pass on or resell the semen to third parties, or to use it for non-identified mares.  
13.3 If the Mare Owner does not perform the obligation under this article, per breach the penalty will be payment by the Mare Owner to GLOCK Stallions of an immediately due penalty in the full amount of the stud fee.

## Article 14 – Orders

14.1 Orders within the Netherlands can be placed daily until 9:30 a.m.  
14.2 For international orders, an order must be placed the day prior to the carrying out of the order, at the latest up to 08:00 a.m. on the day of carrying out of the order.  
14.3 Requests or orders within the Netherlands are by telephone.  
14.4 If an order cannot be carried out, GLOCK Stallions will notify the Mare Owner thereof as quickly as possible.

## Article 15 – Delivery

15.1 Before GLOCK Stallions proceeds to deliver the semen, the Mare Owner must provide the necessary details of both the Mare Owner and the mare, as laid down in Article 5 of these Terms and Conditions, to GLOCK Stallions before a request or order can be taken into consideration.  
15.2 The Mare Owner can give both his address and the address of a third party as the delivery address.  
15.3 GLOCK Stallions will engage an external courier for the delivery of the semen.  
15.4 Dispatch on Sundays and public holidays is subject to regional limitations.  
15.5 On weekends and on public holidays there will be no delivery abroad.

## Article 16 – Failure to comply with the cover obligation

If GLOCK Stallions cannot perform the cover or the insemination obligation relating to the mare because:

- a veterinarian who is "Equine Veterinarian AI" qualified has determined that the desired semen is of inadequate quality; or
- b. the semen is not available during the optimal time of cover or within 24 hours thereafter, the Mare Owner is entitled to choose another stallion of the same stud fee category. If the Mare Owner opts for a stallion which is not available at GLOCK Stallions, GLOCK Stallions will repay the stud fee within 14 days, provided it has already been paid.

## Article 17 – Liability

17.1 GLOCK Stallions is not in any way liable for loss, illness and/or injury to humans or animals caused by its service or by use or application of the product.

17.2 GLOCK Stallions excludes any liability for any form of loss with regard to the Mare Owner. This explicitly includes any possible loss which the Mare Owner has suffered or will suffer as a direct or indirect consequence of a CEM and/or EVA infection of his or her mare.

17.3 If there is loss, GLOCK Stallions is only liable for direct loss. Any liability of GLOCK Stallions for consequential loss or loss due to delay is explicitly excluded.  
17.4 GLOCK Stallions's obligation to pay compensation is at all times limited to a maximum of the invoice amount paid to GLOCK Stallions or a maximum of the amount that its insurer pays out in that case. If the insurer does not pay out or the loss does not fall under the insurance which has been taken out, the obligation to pay compensation is in any event limited to a maximum of the invoice amount of the order which caused the loss.  
17.5 GLOCK Stallions is never liable for compensation to third parties. The Mare Owner indemnifies GLOCK Stallions against any loss which is suffered by third parties.  
17.6 GLOCK Stallions is explicitly not liable, for whatever reason, for not being able to deliver semen, the late arrival of the semen and/or damage to the product.  
17.7 The limitations of liability laid down in this article do not apply if the loss is due to intent and/or recklessness of GLOCK Stallions or the managerial personnel.

## Article 18 – Force majeure

18.1 Force majeure means: any shortcoming in the performance which cannot be attributed to GLOCK Stallions, because such shortcoming is not attributable to fault on the part of GLOCK Stallions nor should such be at its expense pursuant to the law, legal transactions or common (legal) views.  
18.2 In the event of force majeure, GLOCK Stallions reserves the right to suspend the Mare Owner's order, or to terminate the Contract without judicial intervention, by means of a written statement by letter or by email.  
18.3 Loss arising as a result of force majeure cannot be attributed to GLOCK Stallions.

## Article 19 – Cooling-off period for consumer purchase

In view of the fact that the semen is a perishable commodity, the Mare Owner is not entitled to revoke and consequently a cooling-off period within the meaning of the Dutch Distance Selling Act does not apply.

## Article 20 – Complaints procedure

20.1 GLOCK Stallions handles complaints in accordance with its complaints procedure. Complaints regarding the performance of the contract must be presented to GLOCK Stallions within 14 days after the Mare Owner discovered the defects, clearly described in full.  
20.2 Complaints presented to GLOCK Stallions will be answered within a term of 14 days as of the date of receipt. If it is foreseeable that a complaint will require a longer period of time to be dealt with, GLOCK Stallions will answer within the term of 14 days with a notice of receipt and an indication when the Mare Owner can expect a more detailed answer.  
20.3 Mare Owner must in any event give GLOCK Stallions 4 weeks time to resolve the complaint in consultation. After this term a dispute will exist which is eligible for dispute resolution. This provision does not apply if the Mare Owner is not a consumer.

## Article 21 – Disputes

21.1 All disputes ensuing from or connected with a legal relationship between the parties to which these Stud Terms and Conditions apply, will at first instance exclusively be adjudicated by the competent Dutch court of the District Court of Gelderland.  
21.2 These Stud Terms and Conditions and all breeding contracts are governed by Dutch law.

## Article 22 – Translations

If there is a difference between translations of these Additional Stud Terms and Conditions and the Dutch text of these Additional Terms and Conditions, the Dutch text will prevail.
